Overview

In 2019. Bield updated its Rent Policy following advice to combine certain elements of the service charge in the rent to create a more streamlined process for tenants. This approach was also intended to ensure costs could be covered by housing benefit.

Recently, local authorities have requested a clearer breakdown of what is included in rents, and tenants have similarly expressed a desire for greater transparency in understanding the rent structure.

In response, we have began reviewing this policy to explore how we can provide clearer information for both tenants and our local authority partners.

As part of this review, we aim to understand what tenants would like to see in a rent statement and service schedule.
