1.1. A number of policies need to be progressed to bring our policy framework up to date.

# 1.2. These policies include:

- Personal Mobility Vehicles (previously mobility scooter and powered wheelchairs)
- Domestic Abuse
- Unacceptable Actions Policy.
- 1.3. The Partnership Forum are invited to comment on the draft policies.

#### 2. PERSONAL MOBILITY VEHICLES

- 2.1. Bield's Health and Safety Officer highlighted the growing popularity of electronic scooters and electronic bikes, and wanted to ensure we were aware of the risks.
- 2.2. The Mobility Scooter Policy was approved in 2021, to bring clarity and a framework for the storage and use of mobility scooters and powered wheelchairs in Bield developments.





2.3. This policy has been updated to include e-scooters and e-bikes, brought under a new heading of 'Personal Mobility Vehicles'.

## 3. DOMESTIC ABUSE

- 3.1. We would like to introduce a policy on how we will respond to domestic abuse to ensure applicants and tenants receive a consistent response that aligns with best practice.
- 3.2. This will help ensure that we respond in the best way possible to both applicants and tenants experiencing and escaping domestic abuse.
- 3.3. This will put us in a good position in relation to the upcoming legislation that is currently going through the Scottish Par
